## **Directions and parking:**

From the A59, drive into Pendleton, past the Swan with Two Necks pub and take the first right onto Pendleton Road. Drive approx. one mile down the road and turn left onto a farm track (Wymondhouses Farm), drive up to the farm where parking is available. Meeting point is in front Wymondhouses Farm.

## **What we're doing and why:**

Planting trees is important for improving our rivers and streams. They help to provide more stable river banks, filter diffuse pollution, reduce flood risk and maintain cool water temperatures.

Trees also provide important habitat for invertebrates, otters and fish.

## **What to bring:**

Please come prepared for our Great British weather. Please bring clean wellies and if you have a pair of gloves bring them along too, with a drink and a snack to keep you going. We'll provide the rest of the kit as well as brews and biscuits.

All ages are welcome, however under 18s must be accompanied by an adult.
