
### Our area

Healthy rivers and lakes provide benefits to us all but managing the diverse demands placed on them is complex.


The partnership brings organisations together to coordinate actions and ensures that local people are involved in shaping projects. This means our work achieves greater benefits for every pound spent towards our aim of
