

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BROADGATE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of the most westerly footway on Broadgate, Preston from its junction with B5254 Liverpool Road for a distance of 600 metres in a south easterly direction in the city of Preston.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 9th November 2021 until 1800 hours on Monday 13th February 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for cycles using the guild wheel is available via:-

Penwortham Bridge – B5254 Liverpool Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow major flood defence works to be carried out.
