### Flood Risk

Be vigilant & prepare for possible #flooding if you have received a flood warning @EnvAgencyNW.

1 in 6 properties are at risk of #flooding from rivers, the sea & surface water . This number is set to increase due to #climatechange!

## **Flood Planning**

When buying a house you should always consider the #floodrisk to the area and to the property. If you are unsure whether the property is in a flood risk area, you can check the property's long-term risk of #flooding using the @EnvAgency's long-term flood risk map http://bit.ly/2QAv7Bj

# Insurance

#Flooding to a property can cause serious damage if you don't have any #flood protection in place Ensure that you have adequate flood insurance cover for both your buildings & contents.

# Recovery

**Natural Flood Management / Watercourse Responsibilities**
