

Preston and South Ribble Flood Risk Management Scheme

COMMUNITY BENEFITS

- ✓ Flood defence glass panels will be installed to maintain views across the River Ribble.
- ✓ Around 0.35 hectares of new wetland habitat, with dipping ponds and an informal sports area, will be created at Ribble Sidings in South Ribble.
- ✓ We will plant five trees for each tree removed.
- ✓ Bank stabilisation works in four locations will provide new riverbank habitat.
- ✓ New grass football pitches will be installed at Archbishop Temple School.
- ✓ Sections of the Guild Wheel will be resurfaced and improved.
- ✓ We will make improvements to the entrance of Avenham and Miller Park from South Meadow Lane.
- ✓ We will work with local communities throughout the life of the project to consider further community benefits.
