United Utilities sewer diversion – Aynam Road

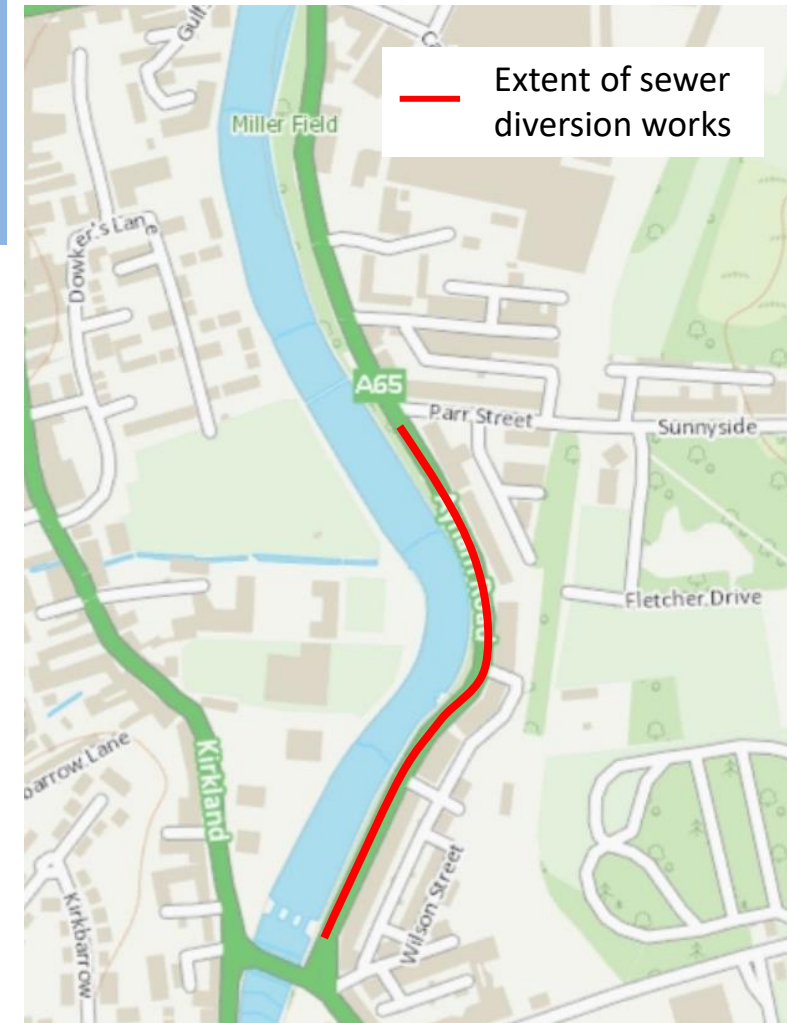
The Environment Agency is delivering a Flood Risk Management Scheme to better protect homes and businesses from flooding in the Kent Catchment and improve the local environment and community amenities. The construction of the scheme in Kendal is well underway and we are now making preparations ahead of construction of the flood walls along Aynam Road.

We are working with United Utilities as they prepare to undertake their sewer diversion works along Aynam Road. The diversion works will start on 14th June for two months. The diversion will be focussed between the areas of Parr Street and Nether Bridge.

In order to deliver the works safely, a lane and footpath closure will be in place along the riverside. During the diversion works, one traffic lane and footpath along Aynam Road will remain open as well as Jennings Yard Footbridge.

We have been advised that United Utilities hours of work will be 8am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation whilst we continue to deliver our works.
