Appleby Town Centre Flood Risk Management Scheme – Doomgate Culvert

United Utilities Service Diversion Works (Doomgate & Holme Street)

Dear Resident,

We are working with various utility providers as there are a number of services which need to be redirected before our works commence. We are writing to inform of you of our upcoming works in the Doomgate/Holme Street area.

Water – United Utilities (UU):

Starting Monday 11th September, we will need to divert the current United Utilities service located at the junction of Doomgate and Holme Street in anticipation for our flood scheme works to commence later in the year. Whilst a full road closure is not required, there will be some temporary traffic management in place in the form of 4-way traffic control signals.

It is anticipated that these works will take approximately 2 weeks and the traffic management will remain in place for the entire duration of these works.

What disruption can you expect?

Due to the traffic management required to undertake the works, several car parking spaces will be out of use for the duration of these works on both Holme Street and Chapel Street.

To safeguard both public and construction teams, it is necessary to have traffic management plans in place. To maintain traffic flow around Appleby, we will implement specific plans for different construction activities and minimise inconvenience where possible.
