

On 30th July we will be undertaking a test of a new piling method along Waterside. This trial will test the success of breaking through underground boulders and rock as we start to construct the foundations for the new glass topped flood wall.

If the trial on 30th is successful, we will be looking to continue the piling works along Waterside. The trial will be undertaken outside of Waterside Cafe on the temporary in river platform, as this is the location where we know the most challenging ground conditions will be.

A number of noise and mitigation measures will be in place to reduce impacts and will be heavily monitored during the works.

Environment Agency and Volkerstevin staff will be on site during the trial. We will undertake doorknocking in the vicinity of the works to check the acceptability of the piling. We will also be outside Waterside Cafe if you would like to come and talk to us.
