Rochdale and Littleborough Flood Risk Management Scheme

Reference – Littleborough Phase 1B Flood Risk Management Scheme (FRMS) Saturday Working Requirement

Dear Resident

Due to unforeseen design issues at the Gale site we are having to alter the methodology for the installation of the box piles which affects a short section of the east embankment piled wall. The equipment required to carry out the piling (CFA rig) is only available for a limited time window, so to ensure works are completed within our programme we will require additional work on Saturdays from 31st August to 14th September. This has been consulted with Rochdale Borough Council Planning Department and Environmental Health Officer and our working hours have been confirmed between 8am and 5pm.

How may this affect you?

- Our weekend working hours will be Saturday only from 08.00 5.00pm.
- You may see an increase in construction vehicles and wagons as we bring in equipment and material onto site. However, during our construction works we will do what we can to keep any noise to a minimum.
- Disturbance is unfortunately unavoidable with this type of construction. The piling may cause noise and vibration, but this will be closely monitored at all times.

We do apologise for the disturbance, but we hope you understand that short-term disruption is unavoidable while we deliver the long-term benefit of the improved flood defences.
