Rochdale and Littleborough Flood Risk Management Scheme

Reference – Littleborough 1B – Gale West Tree Felling

Dear Resident,

As part of the Flood Risk Management Scheme, we will be undertaking some tree removal works in the land between the entrance to our site and Elim Terrace. These works are required for us to prepare the area for our permanent construction works in the New Year.

- Trees are being felled to accommodate permanent works including the new access to the reservoir.
- All trees that are being removed are in accordance with our planning approval.
- Felled trees are to be replaced with replanted trees, exact locations and number of trees are yet to be determined but will be communicated following agreement with Rochdale Borough Council
- We will ensure that the felled trees are re-used for natural flood management schemes or other environmental projects. Details of this will be shared in a future newsletter/communication.

What will we be doing?

- We will be removing trees in the section of land to the South of Todmorden Road between the site entrance and Elim Terrace as highlighted on the plan overleaf.
- We will be installing traffic management on Todmorden Road from 25th November to provide a walkway for pedestrians on Todmorden Road whilst we work adjacent to the footway. These traffic lights will be in place for 1 week.


How will this affect me?

- These works will commence on 18th November 2024 and take approximately 2 weeks to complete.
- We will have traffic lights on Todmorden Road from 25th November which will be manually controlled and turned in at the end of each day for a duration of one week. A pedestrian walkway will also be provided.
- Our working hours during these works will be from 8am to 6pm.

We appreciate your patience as we carry out these works.

Tree Removal Diagram & Plans


