What have we been working on?

A new outfall into the River Eden has been completed and work is progressing on the construction of the new pumping station in Broad Close car park. The riverside footpath has been reopened following completion of the outfall works.

Broad Close car park has been closed to enable the construction of the pumping station control building, valve chamber, wet well and new culverts. Works have begun on the construction of the valve chamber and wet well.



In January, works will continue within Broad Close car park. From mid-February, service diversions will start in Chapel Street which will require traffic management. Further information regarding the traffic management arrangements will be available on thefloodhub.co.uk/appleby.

Access to the toilet facilities in Broad Close car park will be maintained on a best endeavours basis. There may be occasions when the toilets are temporarily inaccessible for specific construction activities, but we will minimise this as much as possible.

We have worked closely with The Oaklea Trust to use the site of the former Edenside care home as a temporary car park following demolition of the existing building. The free temporary car park will open prior to Christmas.
