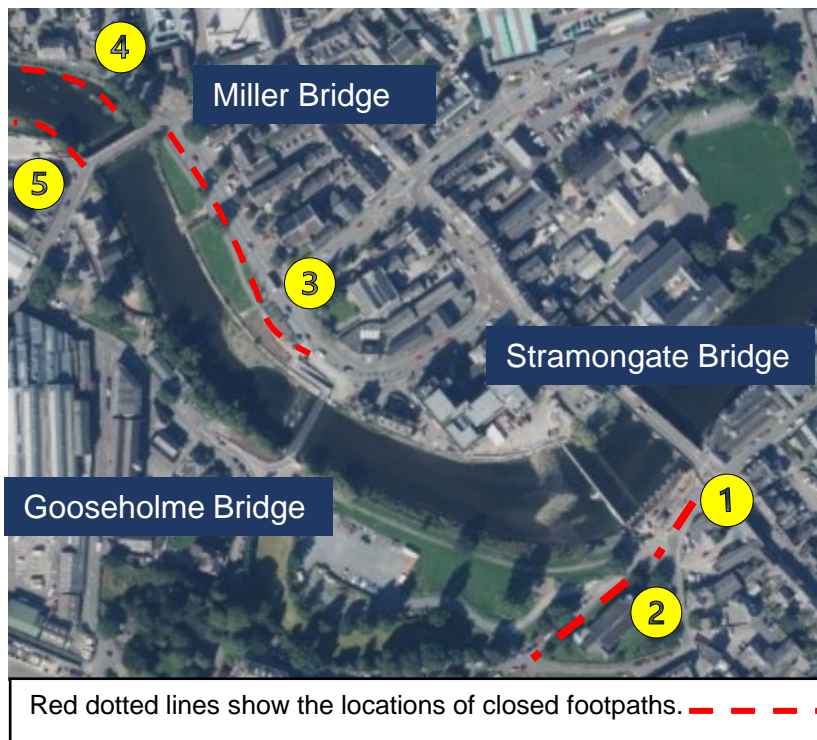


# Kendal Flood Risk Management Scheme - Keeping Kendal moving

We are delivering a Flood Risk Management Scheme that runs from Helsington Mills in the southern end to Mintsfeet in the northern end of Kendal. The complex nature of delivering a long linear scheme through a busy town centre has led us to break down the scheme into small sections we term as 'reaches'. The order of work is influenced by minimising disruption within the town and ensuring we manage flood risk during our construction works.

Our primary aim throughout our construction works is to ensure we keep Kendal moving, and is fundamental to how we order the delivery of our works. There will be some disruption to areas along the riverside as we balance the need to keep our contractors, the community, and visitors safe, whilst keeping construction active.

Riverside footpaths will be temporarily closed whilst working in these areas, but we will aim to ensure there is always an alternative footpath open. Our Traffic Management Plan has been developed in conjunction with Westmorland & Furness Council which ensures any temporary road closures or lane closures are managed appropriately to minimise any traffic disruption. All road bridges will remain open for access at all times, and only one road closure will be required at Waterside whilst we deliver works within this location. Temporary lane closures on Aynam Road and New Road will be in place during all pre construction and construction works. We will always ensure within these two key locations that at least one lane will remain open at all times to keep traffic moving.



**1** Stramongate Bridge – The footpath leading from Stramongate Bridge onto Castle Street is currently closed until Autumn 2025.

**2** St Georges' Walk – The footpath and road is closed until Autumn 2025

**3** New Road Common – The footpath through the common will be closed until Summer 2025. Access to Gooseholme bridge will be maintained. A lane closure is also in place.

**4** Waterside Café - The area along the riverside between Waterside Café and Edgecombe Court will be closed at times of construction activity. Work will resume in this area from Spring 2025 to Autumn 2025 and during this period, the footpath/highway will be closed.

**5** Aynam Road North – The riverside footpath at Miller Fields is closed and will remain closed throughout 2025. A lane closure in this location is also in place between Miller Bridge and Jennings Footbridge. There will be times a full lane closure will be in place between Miller Bridge and Nether Bridge due to riverside activities.
