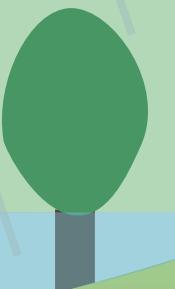
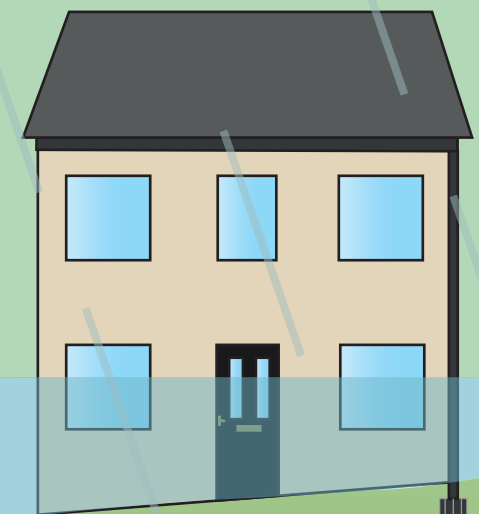
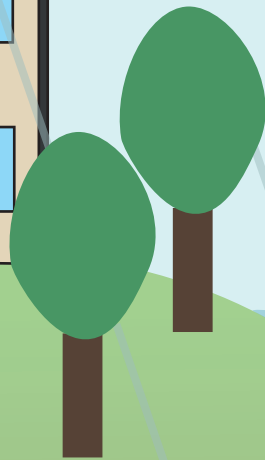
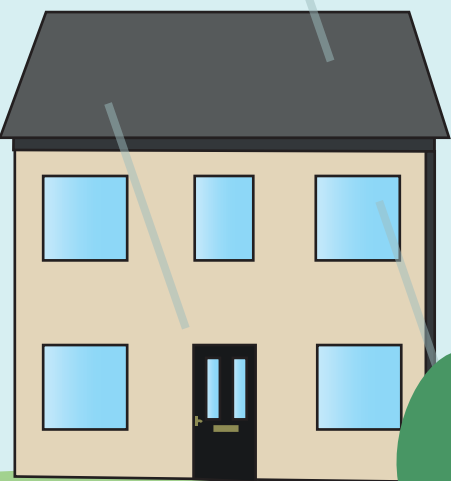


# RIVER FLOODING
