

Kendal Flood Risk Management Scheme

Visualisations showing what the flood scheme along Aynam Road will look like once complete



The flood scheme will incorporate a range of public realm features along Aynam Road.



The north end of the river near Miller Bridge, Webster railings will create a gateway onto a new riverside footpath.



Along the central section of Aynam Road, glass panels will retain much loved riverside views.



At the southern end of Aynam Road a new flood wall will host a viewing platform up the river and a new access down to the ford.

Programme of works for early 2026 subject to Electricity North West Diversion completion



- Traffic Management in place along the riverside vehicle lane
- Trial holes along Aynam Road riverside to test the ground conditions to inform the piling works
- Final checks on diverted underground services to ensure they are disconnected and safe
- First site preparations to get ready for construction



Pedestrian and vehicle diversions

The traffic management is currently not in place due to a service diversion works being undertaken by Electricity North West. The traffic management will be put back in place along the riverside vehicle lane in late February as we start to undertake riverside works. When the traffic management is reinstated, all traffic and pedestrians will be directed to use the left-hand vehicle lane and footpath along Aynam Road.
